





• To develop and test a method for promoting participation among children/youth/young adults with functional difficulties





  - Never (1), Seldom (2), Sometimes (3), Often (4), Very often (5)

### Satisfaction with own participation:

- How satsified are you with your own participation when you are .....
  - Very satisfied (5), Satisfied (4), Neither nor (3), Dissatisfied (2), Very dissatisfied (1)






## **Operationalisation of disability**

  - A lot of difficulty or more on at least one question (N = 62)






### **Comparing participation between municipalities**






### Comparing children and youth with and without disabilities -




